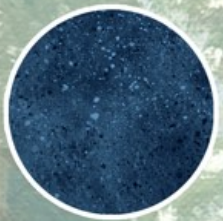

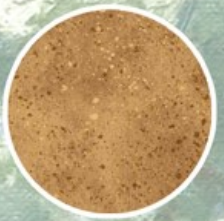

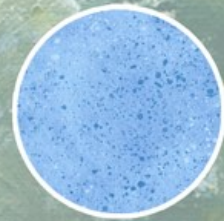

Winter Enchantment

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

Twin Quilt Instructions

approximate size: 63" x 87"

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - **cut 2 - 16 1/2" x 23" (center designs evenly)


Fabric B - cut lengthwise: 2 - 7 1/4" x 36 1/2" and 4 - 2 1/2" x 10 1/2"

Fabric C - fussy cut: 2 - 6" x 10 1/2" and 10 - 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares (center designs evenly)

Fabric D - cut 2 - 6" x 10 1/2"


Fabric F - cut 5 - 2 1/2" strips (4-patches)


cut 6 - 2" strips (checkerboard)


cut 4 - 2 7/8" strips, subcut 40 - 2 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally for 80 triangles  (focal blocks)

Borders: cut 4 - 1 1/2" strips, subcut 4 - 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" and 4 - 1 1/2" x 12 1/2"

cut 8 - 2 1/2" strips, sew end to end then subcut 2 - 2 1/2" x 82 1/2" and 2 - 2 1/2" x 62 1/2"

Fabric H - cut 3 - 4 7/8" strips, subcut 20 - 4 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally for 40 triangles  (chain blocks)

Fabric I - cut 2 - 5 1/4" strips, subcut 10 - 5 1/4" squares, cut in half diagonally from both directions for 40 triangles  (focal blocks)

cut 3 - 4 7/8" strips, subcut 20 - 4 7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally for 40 triangles  (chain blocks)

cut 10 - 1 1/2" strips, sew end to end then subcut 4 - 1 1/2" x 36 1/2", 2 - 1 1/2" x 61" and 2 - 1 1/2" x 38 1/2"

BINDING - cut 8 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

Fabric J - **cut 2 - 1 1/4" strips, subcut 4 - 1 1/4" x 16 1/2"

**cut 4 - 1" x 24 1/2"

cut 3 - 2 1/2" strips, subcut 40 - 2 1/2" squares (focal block)

cut 5 - 2 1/2" strips (4-patches)

cut 6 - 2" strips (checkerboard)

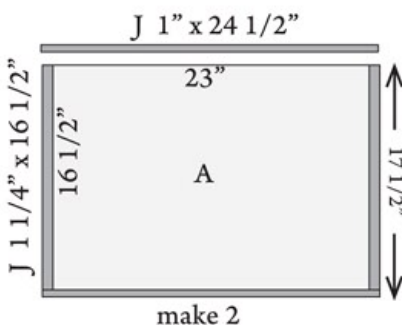
Borders: cut 12 - 1 1/2" strips, sew end to end then subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 63", 2 - 1 1/2" x 80 1/2" and

2 - 1 1/2" x 58 1/2"

cut 2 - 1 1/4" strips, subcut 2 - 1 1/4" x 40 1/2"

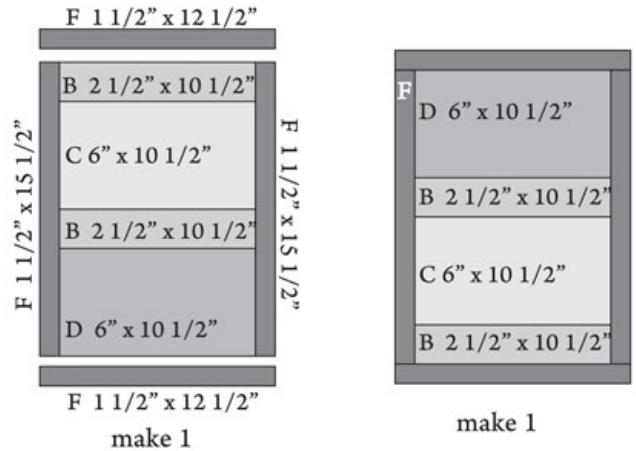
2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew **J** 1 1/2" x 16 1/2" to the **SIDES** of 2 **A** 16 1/2" x 23", then sew **J** 1" x 24 1/2" to the **TOP** and **BOTTOM** of both blocks according to the diagram.

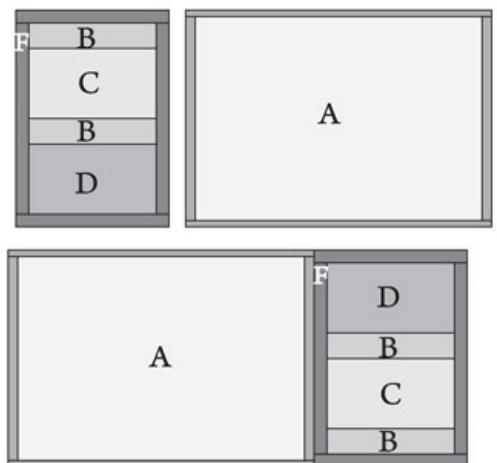


** (If **A** measurements are slightly different, cut **J** borders slightly larger, sew around **A**, then trim both blocks to measure 17 1/2" x 24 1/2".)

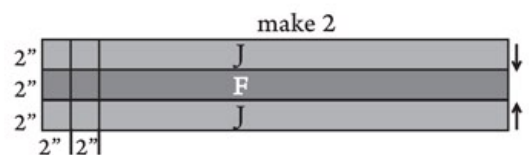
2. Make 1 block by sewing **B**, **C**, **B** and **D** strips side by side. Make another block by sewing **D**, **B**, **C**, **B** strips side by side. Then sew **F** 1 1/2" borders around both blocks, **SIDES** first, the **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders according to the diagram.



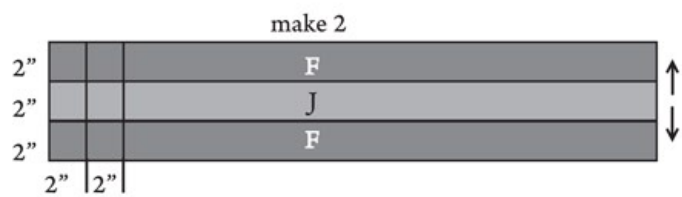
3. Sew one block from step 2 to the left side of one **A** block and sew the other block from step 2 to the right side of another **A** block according to the diagram. Then sew both rows together for the quilt center.



4. Make checkerboard rows by first sewing 2 strip sets of **J**, **F**, **J** 2" strips side by side. Press toward **F**. Subcut 24 - 2" segments.

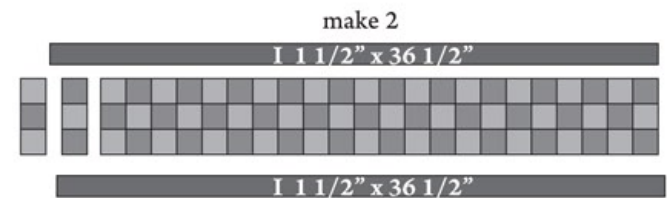


Next, make 2 strip sets by sewing **F, J, F** 2" strips side by side. Press toward **F**. Subcut 24 - 2" segments.



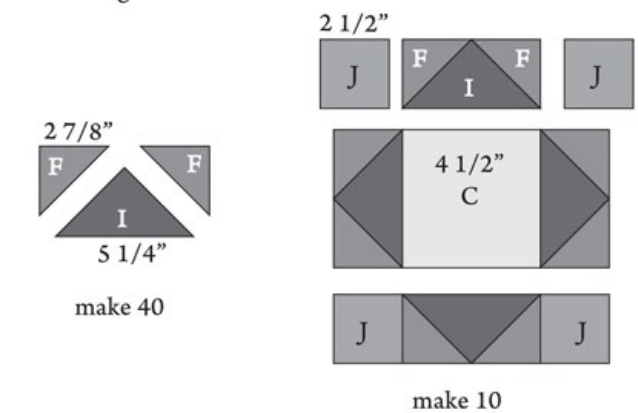
Then make 2 rows by alternating 12 segments from both strip sets (for a total of 24 segments) according to the diagram.

Sew **I** 1 1/2" x 36 1/2" above and below both checkerboard rows. Then sew checkerboard rows above and below quilt center according to the diagram on the next page.

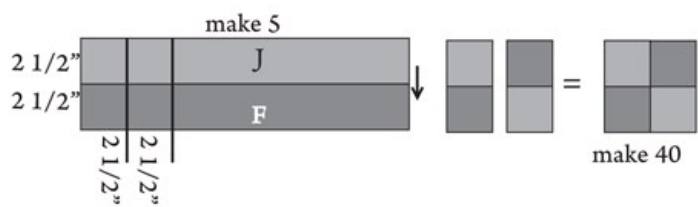
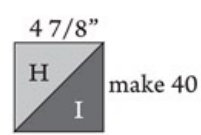


5. Sew **B** 7 1/2" x 36 1/2" above and below quilt center. Next, sew **I** 1 1/2" borders around the quilt, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders. Then sew **J** 1 1/2" x 63" to the quilt's **SIDES** and sew **J** 1 1/4" x 40 1/2" to the **TOP** and **BOTTOM** according to the diagram on the next page.

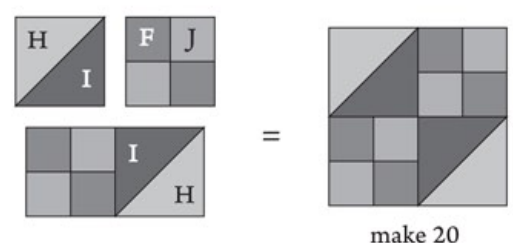
6. Make 10 - 8" finished (8 1/2" unf.) pieced focal blocks. First, sew **F** 2 7/8" triangles to both sides of **I** 5 1/4" triangles, then sew blocks together by rows according to the diagram.



7. Make 20 - 8" finished (8 1/2" unf.) chain blocks. First, make 40 half square triangle units by sewing **I** and **H** 4 7/8" triangles together. Then make 40 4-patches: make 5 strip sets by sewing **J** and **F** 2 1/2" strips side by side. Press toward **F**. Subcut 80 - 2 1/2" segments. Then sew segments together for 40 4-patches according to the diagram.



Then sew 4-patches and half square triangle units together by rows.



8. Make 2 **SIDE** borders alternating 6 chain blocks and 2 focal blocks. Pay special attention to the direction of the focal blocks according to the cover picture. Then sew to the **SIDES** of the quilt center according to the diagram on the next page.

9. Make the **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders by alternating 3 focal blocks and 4 chain blocks according to the diagram on the next page. Then sew to the quilt's **TOP** and **BOTTOM**.

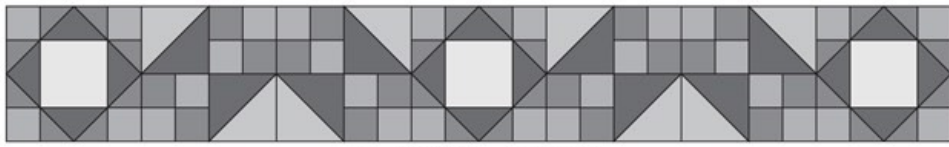
10. Sew **J** 1 1/2" borders around the quilt, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders.

11. Sew **F** 2 1/2" borders around the quilt, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders according to the diagram on the next page.

12. The Twin quilt measures approximately 63" x 87". Make backing (**Fabric H**) at least 6" larger than the top. Layer and baste top, batting and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric I**) and enjoy!!

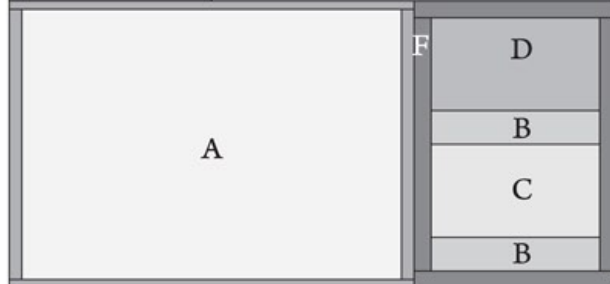
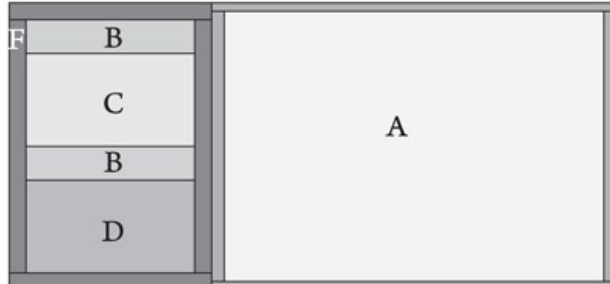

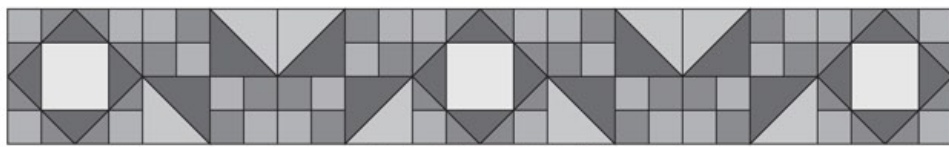

Wall Hanging Instructions

approximate size: 36 1/2" x 63 3/4"

page 4

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - **cut 2 - 16 1/2" x 23" (center designs evenly)

Fabric B - cut lengthwise: 1 - 13 1/4" x 24"

Fabric E - cut 2 - 2 1/2" strips, subcut 2 - 2 1/2" x 24"

Borders - cut 5 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end then subcut 2 - 2 1/4" x 51 1/4" and 2 - 2 1/4" x 27 1/2"

Fabric G - Borders - cut 5 - 4" strips, sew end to end then subcut 2 - 4" x 56 3/4" and 2 - 4" x 36 1/2"

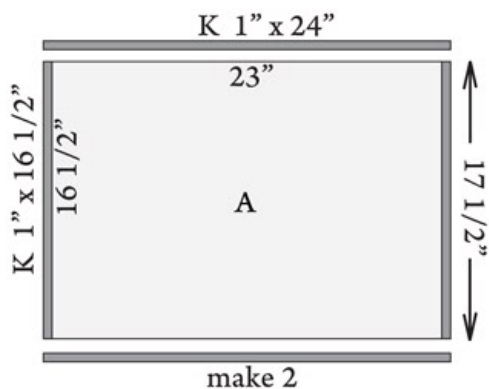
Fabric K - **cut 6 - 1" strips, subcut 4 - 1" x 16 1/2" and 4 - 1" x 24"

Borders - cut 5 - 1 1/2" strips, sew end to end then subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 54 3/4" and 2 - 1 1/2" x 29 1/2"

BINDING - cut 6 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew **K** 1" borders around 2 **A** rectangles, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders according to the diagram. ** (If **A** measurements are slightly different, cut **K** borders slightly larger, sew around **A** rectangles, then trim both blocks to measure 17 1/2" x 24".)

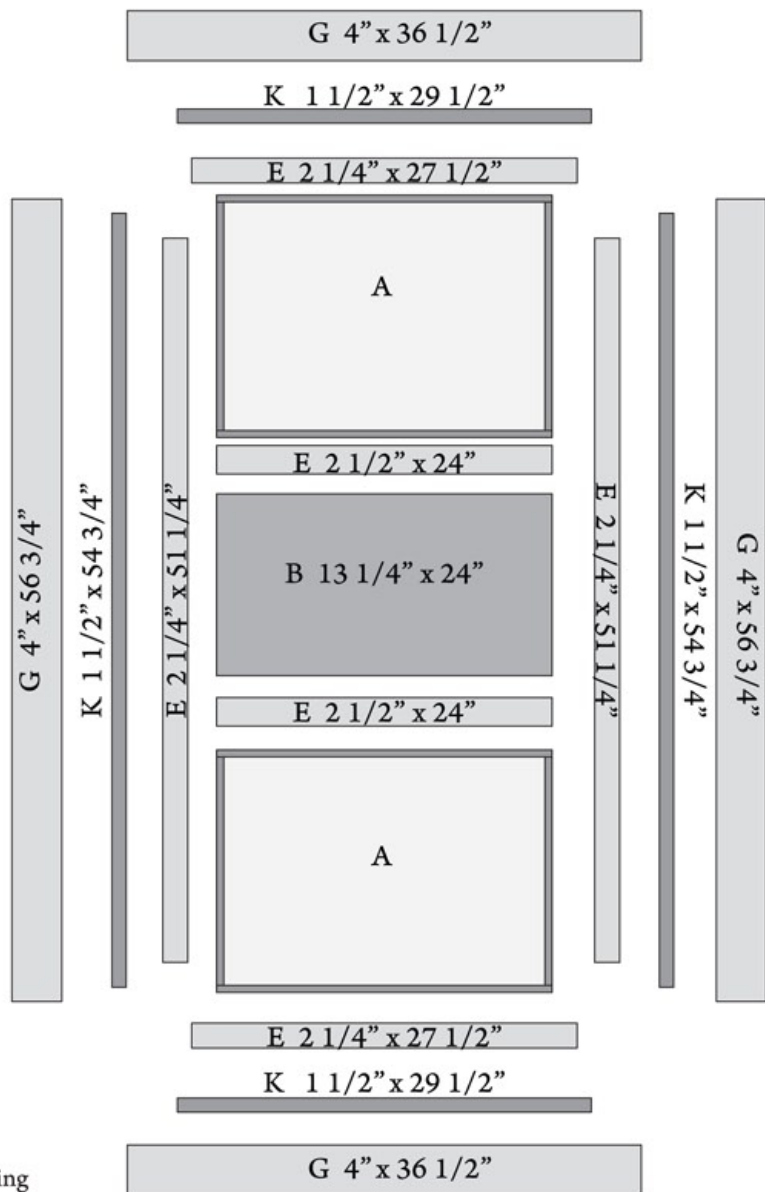


2. Sew **E** 2 1/2" x 24" above and below **B** 13 1/4" x 24". Then sew **A** bordered blocks above and below **E** strips according to the diagram.

3. Sew **E** 2 1/4" borders around the quilt, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders.

4. Sew **K** 1 1/2" borders around the quilt, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders.

5. Last, sew **G** 4" borders around the quilt, **SIDES** first, then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders according to the diagram.



6. The Wall Hanging measures approximately 36 1/2" x 63 3/4". Make backing (**Fabric E**) at least 6" larger than the top. Layer and baste top, batting and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric K**) and enjoy!!
